



# I Baffle Installation Guide

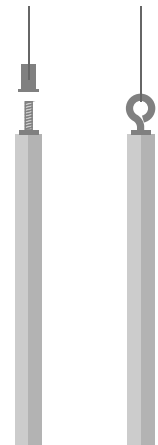

## Installation

Due to the great variance in over head environments, our guidelines are meant to provide suggested placement only. Exact placement and suspension methods are subject to design specification, regional code, site-specific requirements, and installer judgment.

*Note: Installers are responsible for supplying the 3/64" - 1/16" aircraft cable and the code compliant ceiling mounting hardware. Kirei does not provide ceiling mounting hardware or cable/chain/rod.*

1. The safest and easiest install is achieved by evaluating the location in advance. Typically two people are needed for most install applications. The baffles are shipped ready to install, no assembly required. Remove baffles from packaging, confirm color and undamaged condition, and compatibility of your hanging hardware.
2. Each baffle has two attachment points and comes with your choice of eyebolts or 1/4" - 20 male threaded screw hardware. Attach appropriate ceiling mounting hardware and suspension cable/chain/rod/etc. with appropriate terminal connector at the bottom end.
3. Once ceiling hardware is securely mounted carefully lay out, install, and level the baffles.



## Work Safety

In the interest of work safety, it is recommended that people working with I Baffle wear the appropriate safety equipment. Although the product emits zero off-gases, masks and gloves should be worn to ensure the maximum possible safety precautions.
